Application Requirements and Qualification Criteria

Application to Include:

1. Resume (please include your family home address as well as your school address and telephone numbers where you can be contacted.)
2. Official certified copy of most recent college grade transcript.
3. A letter of recommendation from one of your transportation/logistics professors.
4. A one-page composition (original writing) involving your major field of study.

**APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED, EMAILED OR
FORWARDED BY OVERNIGHT SERVICE NO LATER THAN
FEBRUARY 5, 2010**

Qualification Criteria:

1. Student must be currently enrolled in an accredited four-year college program (US) with a major in a broad field of transportation, distribution, logistics or supply chain management.
2. Student must have completed his/her sophomore year (or one half of graduating credit requirements) and a minimum of two courses in the major field of study to qualify for consideration.
3. Student must provide a certified transcript indicating that a minimum cumulative, as well as major, grade point average of 2.75 (on a 4.0 based scale), has been maintained.
4. Selected candidates **MUST** be present in Pittsburgh on the occasion of The Traffic Club of Pittsburgh Annual Dinner (Thursday March 11, 2010) in person to receive their \$2,500 scholarship award.

Where all other selection criteria are judged to be equal, the Club may give preference to Pennsylvania residents, applicants with a hometown within 100 air miles of Pittsburgh, children of Resident members, or children of Life or Honorary members previously having Resident membership status.
